
Some basic facts

Three sources on funding:


1st: institutional or basic funding (government)

2nd: funding through intermediary organisations (government)

3rd: the money that comes in through research projects and grants (third parties, incl. EU funding)






Some basic facts

Between 2019-2022

- In total, UvA coordinated 113 EU- funded projects and participated as partner in 100.
- Total of €142.5M acquired from EU funds between 2019-2022, incl.:
 - €34.31M acquired from RIA funds (24% of UvA's total EU-derived funding).
 - €77.2M acquired from ERC funds (54% of UvA's total EU-derived funding).




UvA Grant Support - decentralized




IXA UvA Grant Advise Team

IXA – Innovation Exchange Amsterdam

- 10 grant advisors, spread across faculties, providing pre-award support to researchers
- focus on individual grants
- pre-award works together with faculty-based financial support
- no integrated post-award support



Research support within the FMG




Post-award support at FMG – individual grants





Post-award support at FMG — collaborative grants (project manager ~ one-stop-shop)




CORE's research support cycle

- Focus on EU-funded collaborative projects.
- Support offered is comprehensive & integrated.
- **Scope of pre-award** support depends on the time left to deadline.
- For a sustainable cycle (researchers moving to another application round after a successful execution and follow-up of a project), post-award is as important as preaward.






