Funding of Research and Development in NL

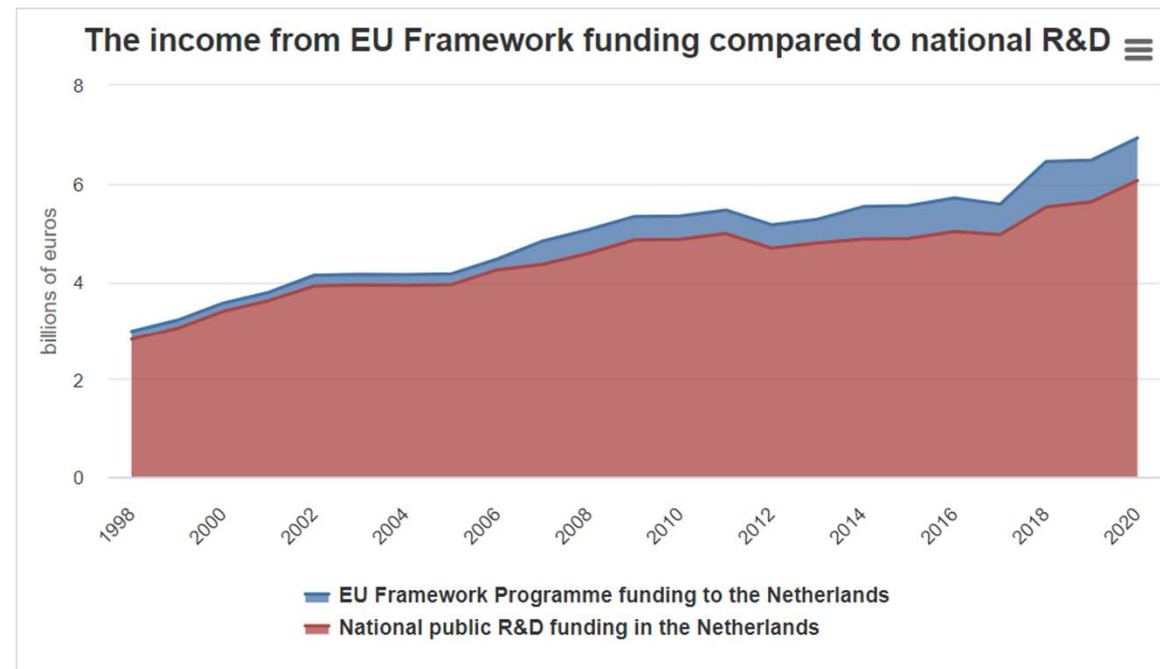
Some basic facts

Three sources on funding:

1st: institutional or basic funding (government)

2nd: funding through intermediary organisations (government)

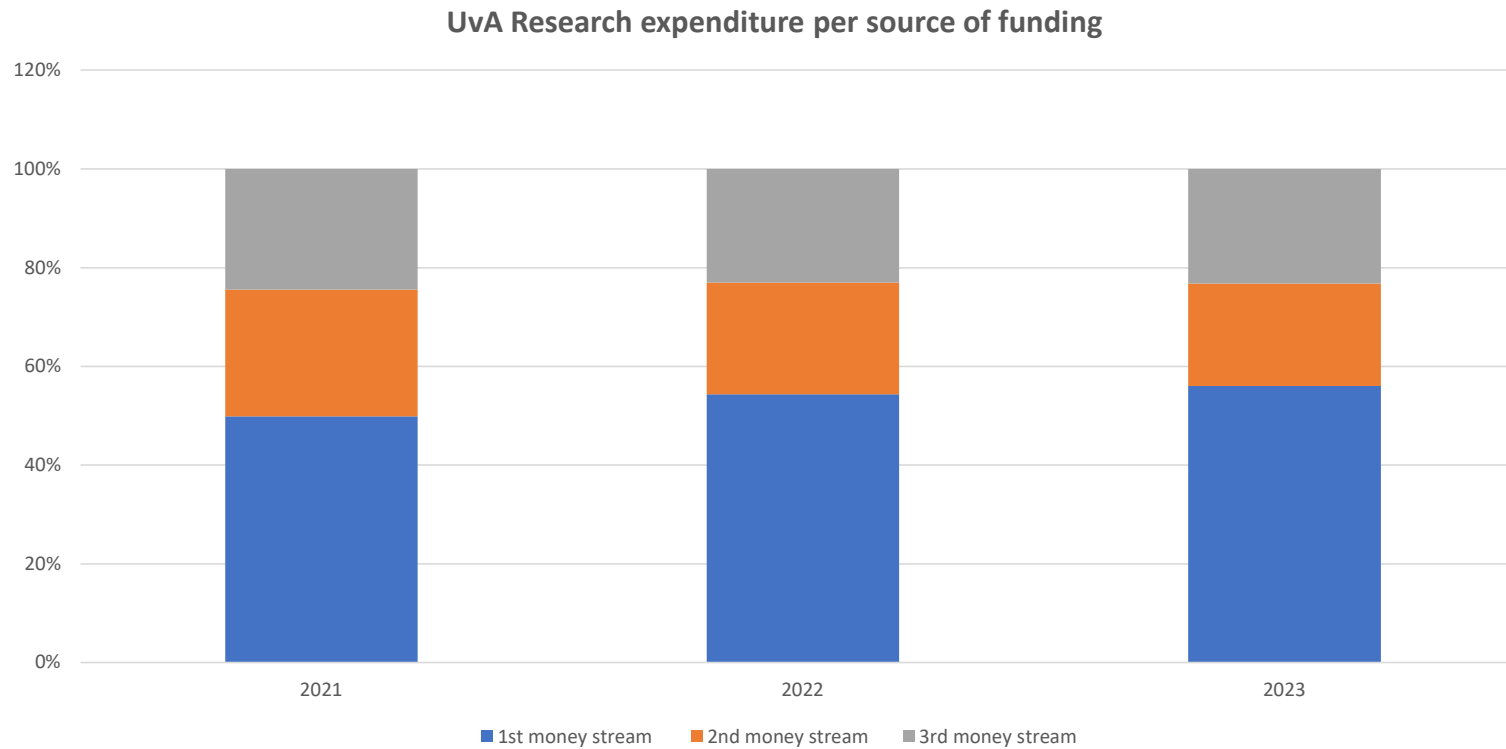
3rd: the money that comes in through research projects and grants (third parties, incl. EU funding)

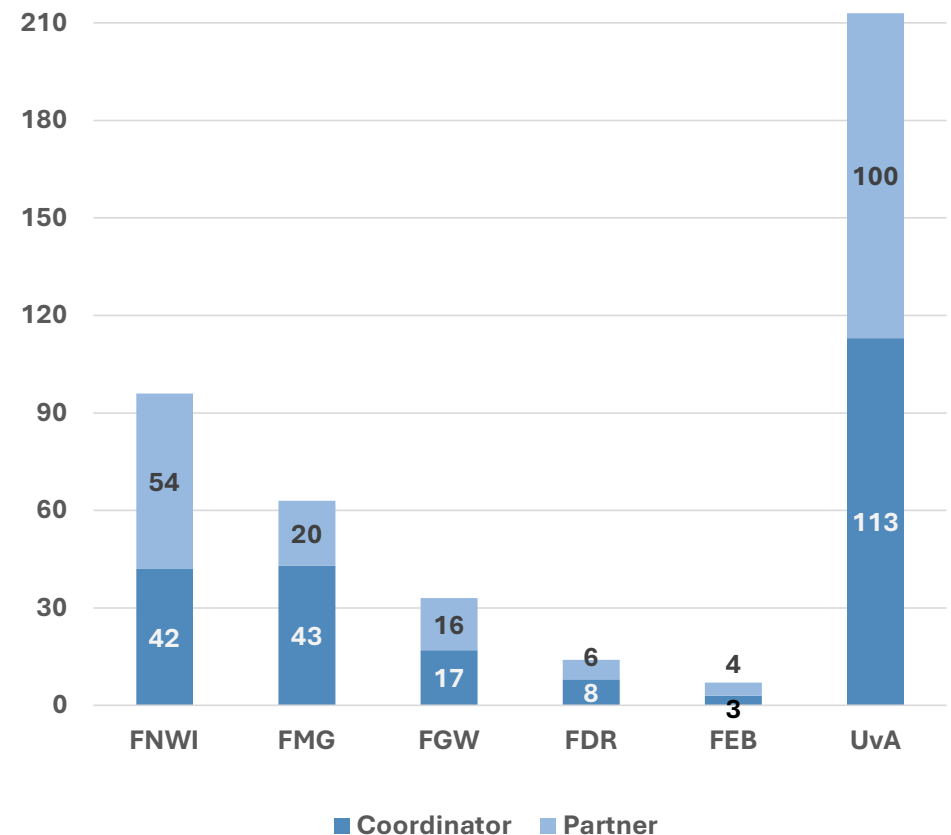

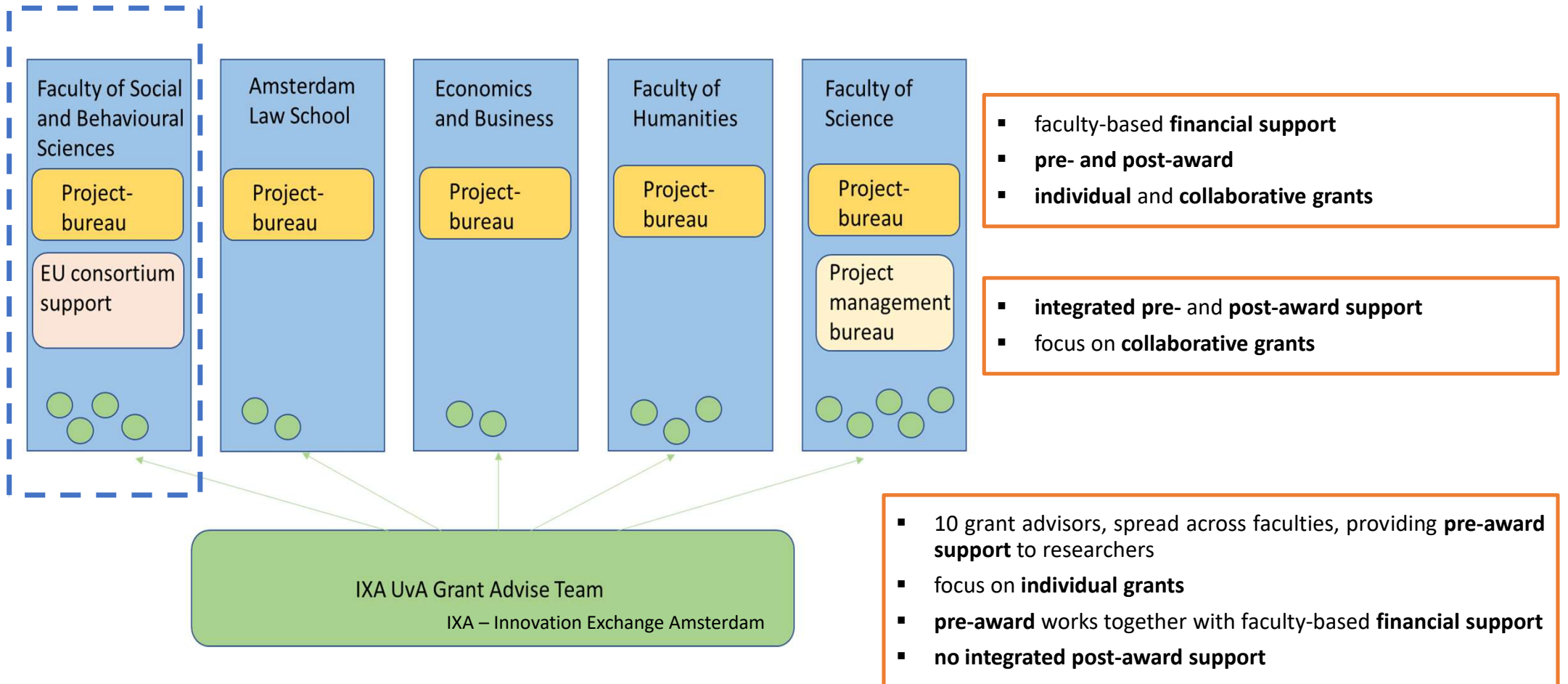
Some basic facts

Between 2019-2022

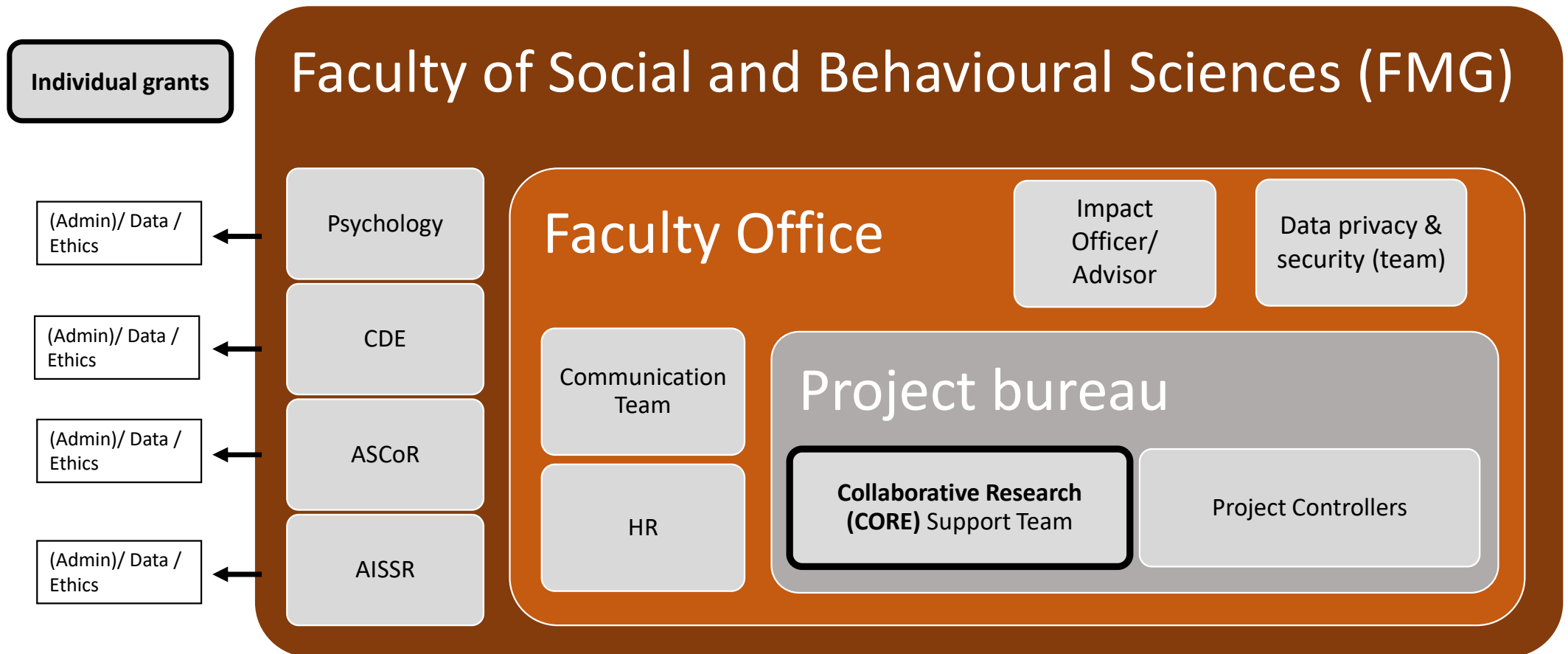
- In total, UvA coordinated **113** EU- funded projects and participated as partner in **100**.
- Total of **€142.5M** acquired from EU funds between 2019-2022, incl.:
 - **€34.31M acquired from** RIA funds (**24%** of UvA's total EU-derived funding).
 - **€77.2M** acquired from ERC funds (**54%** of UvA's total EU-derived funding).

Research support within the FMG



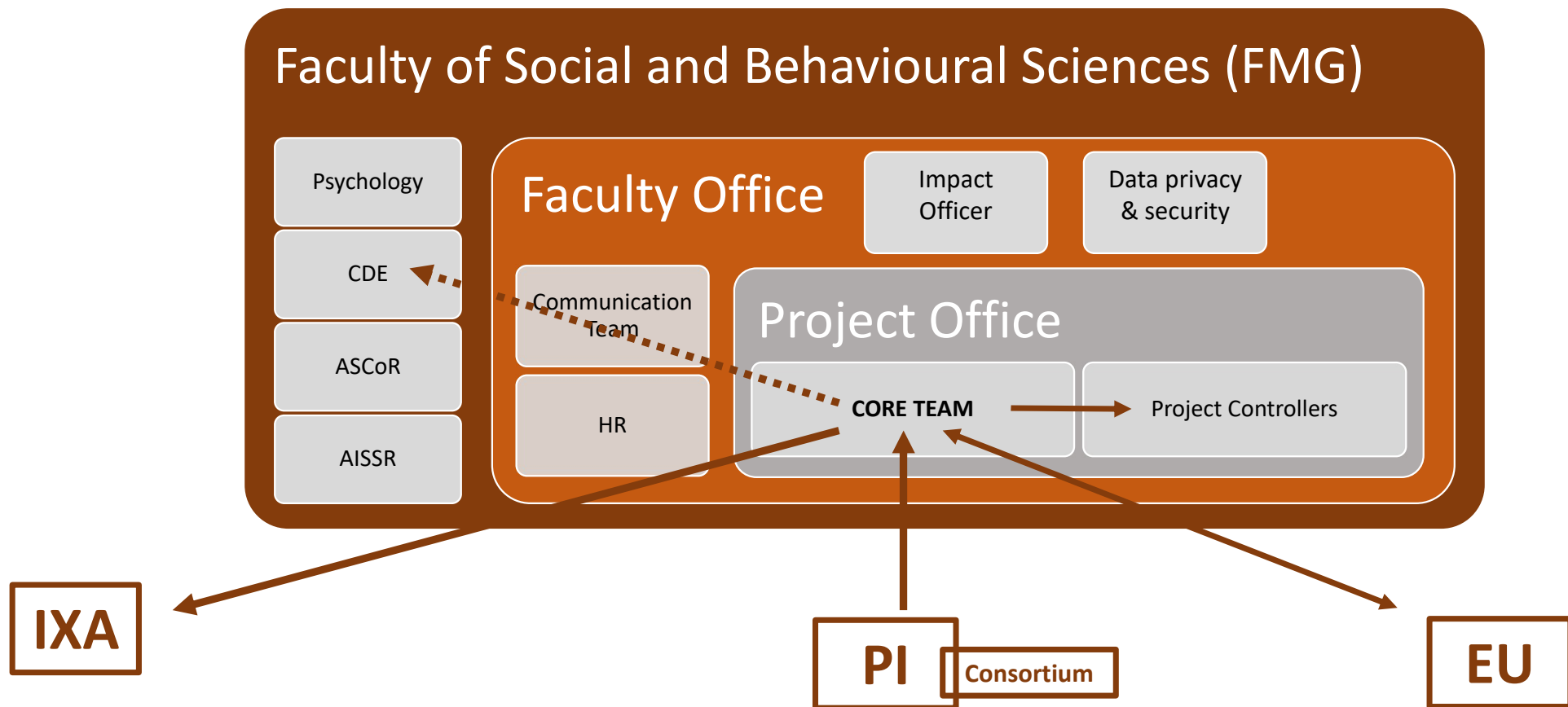
Post-award support at FMG – individual grants

(Researcher pulls all the strings)



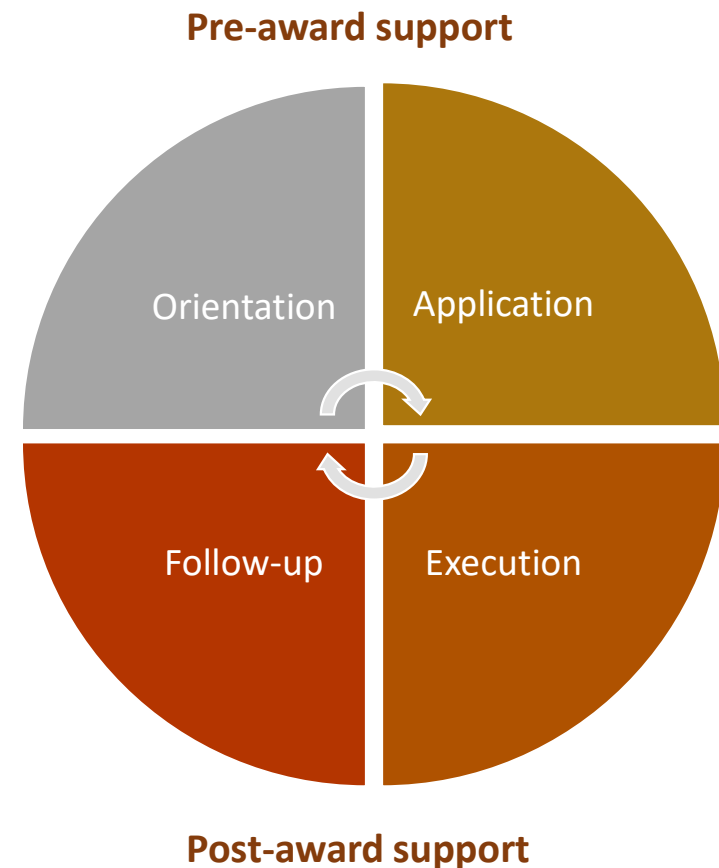
Post-award support at FMG – collaborative grants

(project manager ~ one-stop-shop)



CORE's research support cycle

- **Focus on EU-funded collaborative projects.**
- Support offered is **comprehensive & integrated.**
- **Scope of pre-award** support depends on the time left to deadline.
- **For a sustainable cycle** (researchers moving to another application round after a successful execution and follow-up of a project), **post-award is as important as pre-award.**

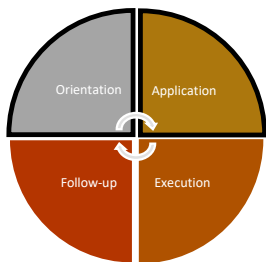

- Review (capacity-dependent)

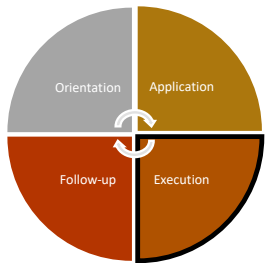
3 Months (minor support)

- Ad hoc advice on specific questions
- Reference to legal, financial, institutional rules

At this stage, the support is dependent on the capacity available in the team

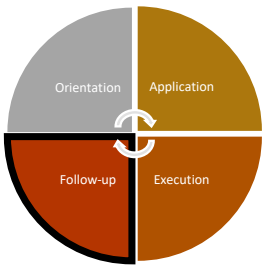

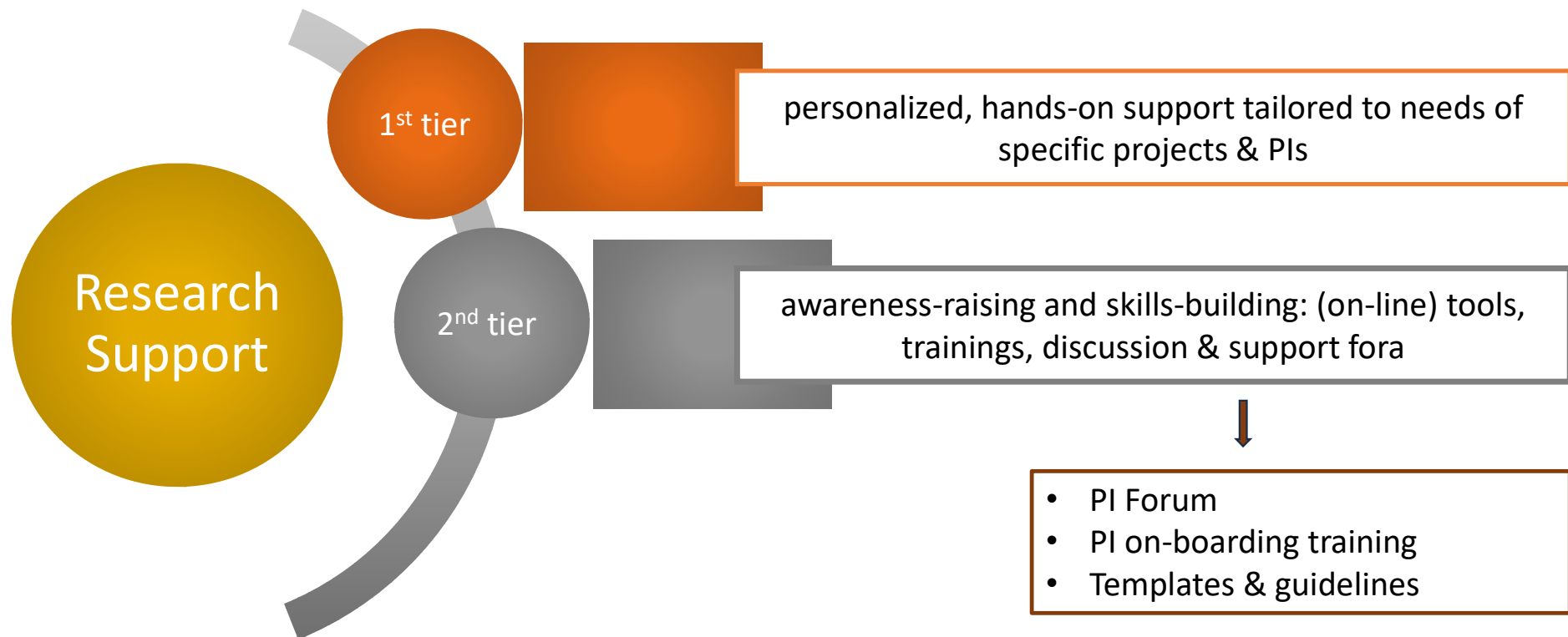

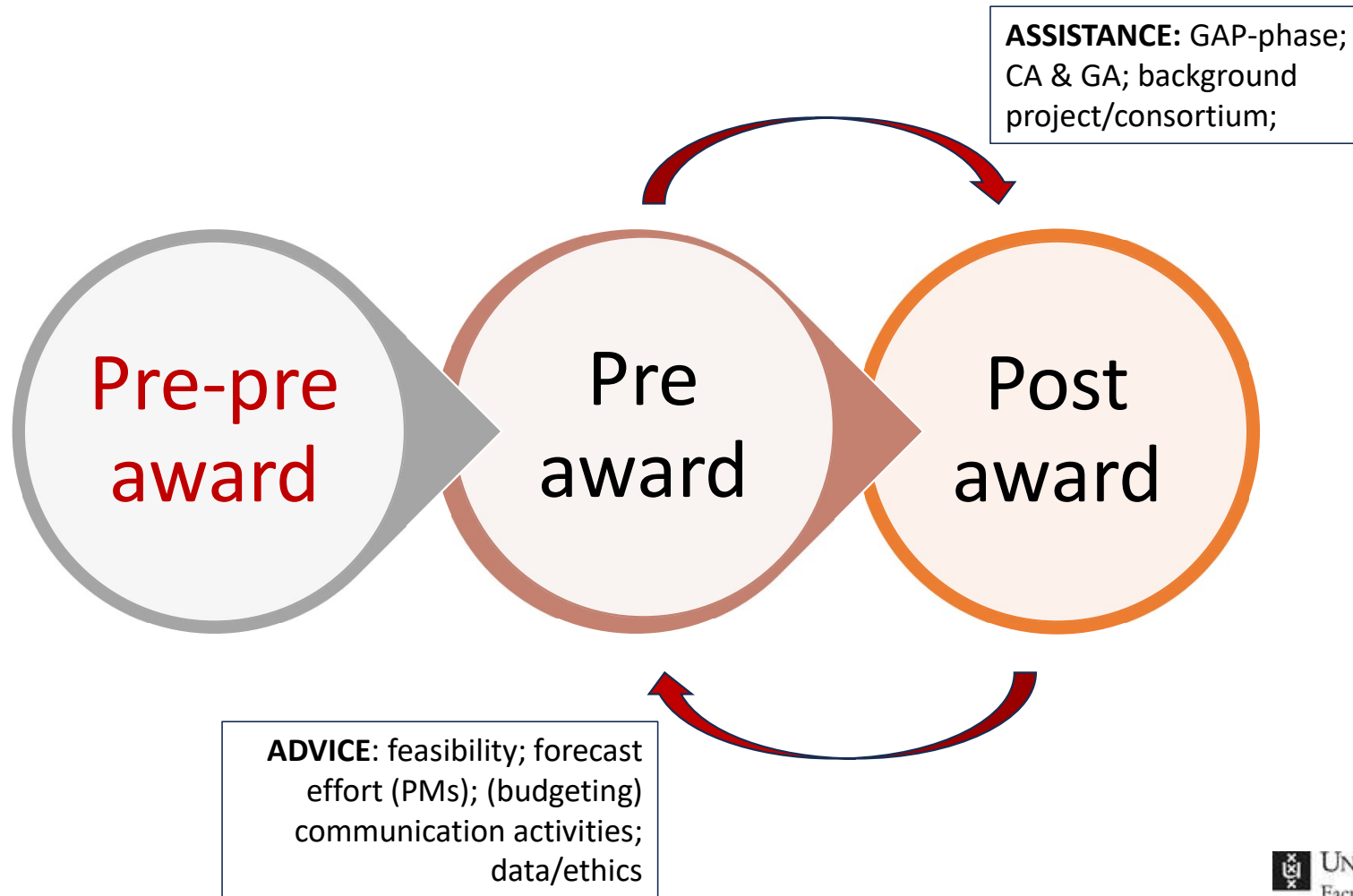
